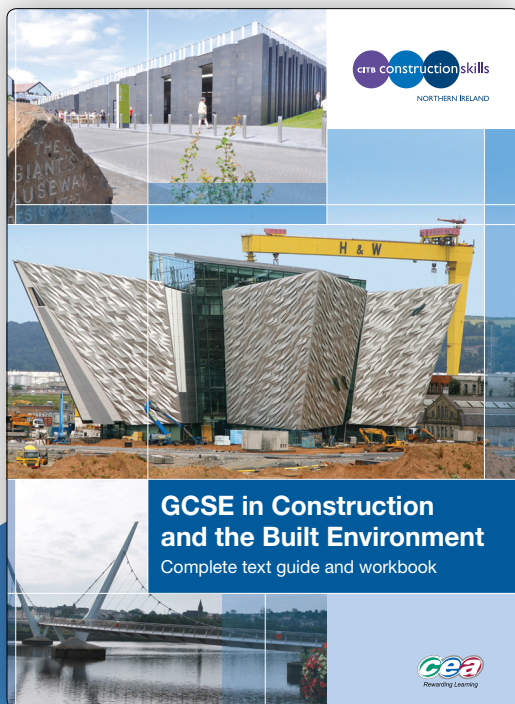


Revised GCSE Construction Textbook

The textbook contains all the essential underpinning knowledge required of a student who has never studied construction before and who wishes to explore the subject for the first time.

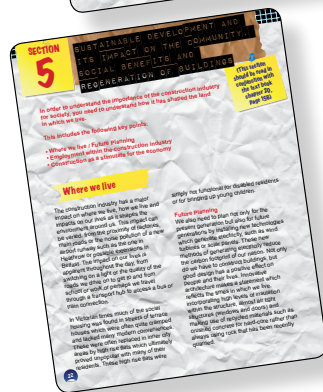
Topics covered include:-
