



An Introduction to working in the Built Heritage Sector

Level 3 Award in Understanding Repair &
Maintenance of Traditional (Pre-1919) Buildings



CITB NI through the Heritage Lottery Funded project Sustaining Traditional Building Skills in NI seeks to develop the capacity of the construction Industry labour force to engage in the conservation, maintenance and repair of the provinces pre-1919 building stock. It is estimated that 16% of Northern Ireland's total building stock is in this category.

In conjunction with Belfast Metropolitan College, South Eastern Regional College (SERC) and South West College (SWC), CITB NI are delighted to announce the delivery of an introductory 30 hour training programme: Understanding Repair and Maintenance of Traditional pre-1919 Buildings. The programme will be delivered at each of the 3 colleges, providing an introduction to Repair and Maintenance in the Built Heritage Sector.

Course Content:

This programme provides an opportunity to undertake the Cskills Awards Level 3 in Understanding Repair and Maintenance of Traditional pre-1919 Buildings, in addition an opportunity will be available to participate in a range of practical activities to underpin the classroom based learning. The programme concludes with a progression workshop where participants will find out about additional training and development opportunities which exist; including progressing to the Level 3 NVQ Diploma in Heritage Skills (Construction), pending practical experience and employment.

Course participants will:

- Develop an understanding of the importance of repairing and maintaining traditional (pre-1919) buildings
- Be provided with an overview of the importance of using traditional building methods and materials when repairing and maintaining traditional buildings
- Receive an introduction to repairing and maintaining traditional buildings through practical workshops

Costs: £45 + £68 registration fee
