FOR NORTHERN IRELAND

This session will outline the equality duties placed on employers in Northern Ireland and how the Equality Commission can assist them in meeting these duties. The role that good equal opportunities practices can play in helping employers in the Construction Sector to successfully bid for public contracts will be discussed.

HMRC will explain how the construction industry scheme works; if you are a contractor what your obligations are including which contracts fall within the scheme, how to register and how to use the online facility. HMRC will also clarify the importance of employment status and how to verify a subcontractor, and will take a look at the new penalty rules in place.
