It relates to creating, managing and sharing information over the entire lifecycle of a construction project, with the aim to improve efficiency and communication amongst all parties working on a project. As this digitalisation drives sweeping changes across the construction sector leading to new 'informed' ways of working Building Information Modelling (BIM) will enable all workers in the industry to be part of this change.
