

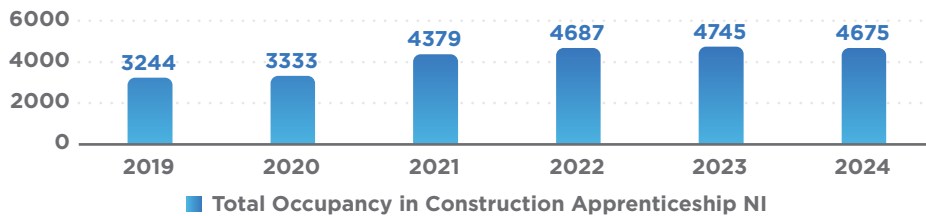
Northern Ireland Construction Apprenticeship Statistics 2024



In Northern Ireland (NI), construction training trends differ from those in the UK, particularly in the areas of traineeships, apprenticeships, and Higher-Level Apprenticeships (HLAs), as NI has experienced steady growth in recent years. Overall, the number of participants in all occupational Apprenticeships in NI has risen consistently, supported by the introduction of all age apprenticeships. CITB NI have provided over £3.1m of grant funding to construction employers, supporting over 1,100 apprentices over the past 9 years.

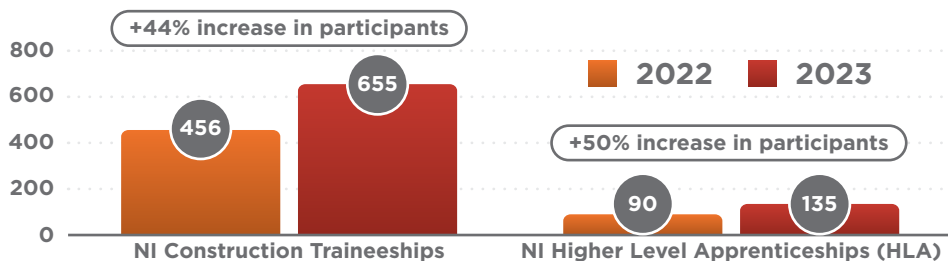

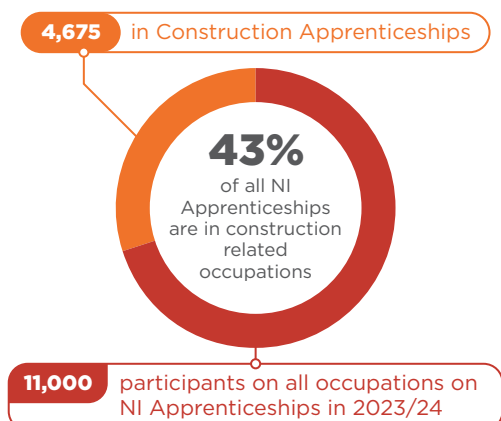
