Colin Stafford of Stafford Construction is one of a number of candidates that have recently completed a Pilot NVQ Level 5 Diploma in Management Programme aimed at Senior Managers within the local construction workforce. The Programme was funded by CITB NI, the Department for Employment and Learning and the Federation of Master Builders and included a number of one day business improvement workshops, as well as providing an opportunity for candidates to work with Investors in People (IIP) and to achieve their Black Managers Industry Registration Card.



Colin is a self-employed building

contractor with over 20 years experience in the industry. The business operates mainly in the Counties of Down, Antrim and Armagh and the main types of work undertaken by Stafford Construction are domestic contracts for new house builds, renovations and general building and joinery works.

Speaking of his reasons for undertaking the Programme, Colin said "I saw this Programme as a real opportunity to develop myself in terms of my management and leadership skills and career prospects, whilst actually achieving an NVQ Level 5 qualification. One of my main reasons was also to make improvements within the business and to help develop the business going forward".

The Programme has indeed had a significant impact on Colin and Stafford Construction, helping to make the business more professional and providing tools and templates that can be used and implemented as the business develops.
