On successful completion of this course participants apply for a BASE Card.

This card is valid for 5 years.

SCAFFOLD SYSTEM PRODUCT TRAINING SCHEME (SSPTS)

To have a scaffold system endorsed on to an existing card after Part One or to renew a BASE card.

On successful completion of this course participants apply to have the scaffold system endorsed on their card or to renew their BASE Card.

CISRS ADVANCED SCAFFOLDING (Tube & Fitting)

For Scaffold card holders wishing to make progress in their scaffolding career having completed the Part Two course at least 12 months previously.

Aim

On successful completion of this course participants will be able to erect, alter and Dismantle scaffolds covered on this course whilst working as part of a team under supervision. An operative is not considered a CISRS Advanced scaffolder until they have completed Advanced Scaffolding training, CISRS 2 DAY SKILLS TEST. NVQ Level 3 and Touch screen test irrelevant of their time in industry.

DURATION: 10 DAYS

Available for people that have not provided workplace evidence to achieve NVQ Level 2.

On successful completion of this course participants renew their Scaffolders card or their Advanced Scaffolders Card.

A valid Health and Safety touch screen test or valid exemption.

At least 12 months after attending Part Two.

Complete application pack and attend for profile.

CISRS SCAFFOLD INSPECTION (Tube & Fitting)

Overview

To carry out scaffold inspections to comply with regulations.

Aim

Provide details to enable participants to inspect scaffolds covered on the course.

DURATION: 3 DAYS

cost: **£410**

Entry Requirements

A valid Health and Safety touch screen test or valid exemption.

Must have a minimum of 6 months supervisory experience on site or hold a CISRS scaffolders card.

Contents Include
