- Make recruiting new staff easier

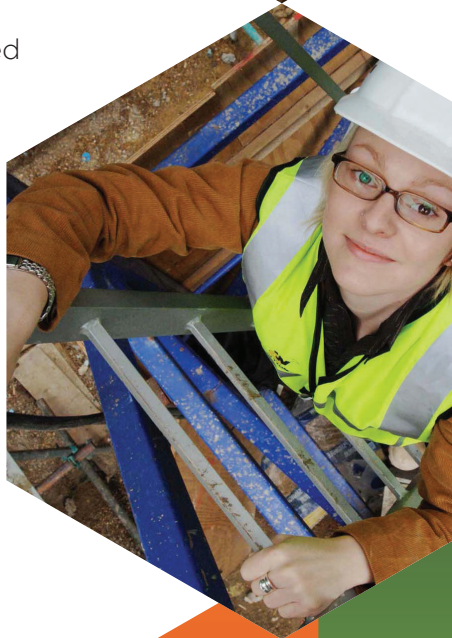
The programme will provide training in 25 skill areas over 3 modules essential for the competent site operative.
