Students will be led by the Department for Communities Historic Environment Division Conservation Works Team, who are responsible for maintaining and repairing Northern Ireland's historic state care monuments.

# HOW TO TAKE PART

This opportunity is free, and open to all young people aged 15-17 across Northern Ireland, who are interested in a career in heritage construction.

However, as activities will be using real tools and materials on a historic site, places are limited to a maximum of 16 students to prioritise health and safety, and maximise opportunities for students to learn from the craftspeople.

Places will be allocated on a first-come-first served basis. Applications should be made by the student's parent or guardian, who should read and agree to the risk assessment appended to the online form.

# ON THE DAY

Parents/ guardians will be required to make travel arrangements to ensure that their child is dropped off and picked up at the appropriate times. Parents/ guardians are also welcome to stay with their child throughout the day if preferred; however it should be noted that facilities are limited.

As there is no café on site, students should bring their own packed lunch. Water will be provided.

Students should wear sensible closed toe shoes or boots, warm clothing in layers, and appropriate outerwear in case of rain, as activities will be taking place semi-outdoors. PPE will be provided.
