HOW TO TAKE PART

This opportunity is free, and open to all built environment students (aged 18+) across Northern Ireland, who are interested learning more about conservation and heritage skills.

However, places are limited to a maximum of 16 students to prioritise health and safety, and maximise learning opportunities.

Places will be allocated on a first-comefirst served basis. Applications should be made online, where you should also read and agree to the risk assessment appended to the form.

Students should also prepare a submission for the associated design competition. This challenge is designed to help you think about how you would approach the reuse of a historic building, and all entries will help to inform discussion on the day. A prize of £300 will be awarded to the winning entry, and £200 to the runner up.

ON THE DAY

Students will be required to make travel arrangements to attend on time, to ensure they do not miss the health & safety briefing. Lunch, tea & coffee will be provided.

Students should wear sensible closed toe shoes or boots, warm clothing in layers, and appropriate outerwear in case of rain, as activities will be taking place semioutdoors. PPE will be provided.
