

Scaffolding Anchorages

1 Day Training Course @ CITB NI Free to Registered CITB NI Companies

24th or 25th June 2015

CITB NI has identified a need to provide competence training and assessment on scaffold structures that are inadequately tied due to a lack of emphasis on anchoring practices. Typical problems include: - anchors for concrete being used in brickwork and anchors not being fully set.

The training will be delivered by an industry expert on scaffolding anchorage who developed and compiled the technical data which has formed the basis of the NASC and CFA recently published Guidance Note, **TG4:11 Anchorage Systems for Scaffolding.** This document provides guidance on the correct selection, installation and testing of scaffolding anchors.

The one day course is designed for both scaffolding erectors and supervisors and covers the theory and practical application of scaffolding anchoring. It is recommended that course participants have at least six months site experience with Advanced Scaffolders being most suitably qualified to achieve the competence assessment. A Certificate of Competence is issued to those who successfully complete the course and assessment test.
