Kilkeel's Josh is named one of the UK's best young plasterers

A KILKEEL student has been named one of the best trainee plasterers in the UK.

Josh McBride travelled last week to the Marshall Arena in Milton Keynes to undertake three intense days of com-

The Kilkeel trainee has consistently delivered in competition settings, having finished second in the Northern Ireland regional finals back in May, and he again delivered last week by winning bronze at the UK finals.

It was all part of this year's SkillBuild National Finals, which took place from Tuesday, 21 to Thursday, 23 November.

Competitors were tasked with constructing a project designed by an expert panel of judges, within an 18-hour timeframe. The project tested the individual's knowledge and skills, as well as their ability to work under pressure within strict timelines, all while adhering to health and safety protocols.

Another local SRC student who competed within the SkillBuild National Finals in Milton Keynes was Niall Rice from Castlewellan who competed in the bricklaying category.
