The Northern Ireland Construction Industry has been greatly impacted by Covid-19, BREXIT and rising inflation costs. No one knows for sure what the future holds, however, recent figures from the Construction Skills Network Labour Market Intelligence Report for Northern Ireland forecasts the volume of construction to grow by an annual average rate of about 2.5% and over 5,000 additional workers will be needed by 2026 to meet the growing demand in the industry, CITB NI's support for training will continue to remain paramount over the upcoming years to serve our industry while it recovers and grows again.
