



APPRENTICESHIP ENDEAVOUR AWARD

TERMS AND CONDITIONS

- 1. The competition is open to apprentices who are resident in Northern Ireland only.
- 2. Only one entry is permitted per apprentice and must be submitted on the competition application form and submitted by the closing date.
- 3. The competition is free to enter.
- 4. The award is £500 and will be paid by cheque to the successful applicant. There is no alternative award.
- 5. Entries will be judged by a selection panel. The panel's decision is final, and no communication will be entered into as to how the panel's decision is reached.
- 6. Copyright in all entries remains with respective entrants. However, in consideration of CITB NI administering the competition, each entrant agrees:
 - a. to grant the partners and media partner(s) a royalty free, worldwide, perpetual licence to use, copy, distribute, publish, republish, store, archive, syndicate, sub-licence, transmit, adapt, edit, create derivative works from, perform, exercise publicity and copyright rights in relation to the entry materials in any manner and in any format and/or media;
 - b. to waive any moral rights in the material submitted; and
 - c. that the partners may disclose your identity to any third party making any claim, enquiry or assertion of any kind in relation to your material.
- 7. In submitting your entry, you warrant that any entry material you submit:
 - a. is your own original work and that you own the copyright and any other relevant rights;
 - b. is not obscene, untrue, threatening, menacing, offensive, defamatory, abusive, in breach of confidence, in breach of any intellectual property right (including, without limitation, copyright) or otherwise in breach of or violates any applicable law or regulation or code; and
 - c. that you shall indemnify the partners and keep them fully indemnified against any third part liability, claims, costs, loss or damage they incur as a result of publishing or dealing with material you submit to them, including consequential losses.
- 8. The entrants may be required to participate in publicity arising from the competition and by entering the competition you agree and provide consent to take part in such publicity.
- 9. These terms and conditions shall be governed by and construed in accordance with Northern Ireland law and the Northern Ireland Courts shall have the exclusive jurisdiction over any dispute which may arise.

- 10. Entry in the competition signifies acceptance of these rules. CITB NI and Radius Housing reserve the right to withhold, change or cancel any award in the event of non-compliance with these rules and reserve the right at their discretion to amend the competition rules at any time.
- 11. Any entry which is illegible or unintelligible may be disqualified. CITB NI and Radius Housing are not responsible for entries that are damaged, delayed, or lost in transit. Proof of sending is not proof of delivery.
