Programme Summary:

This National House Builders Council (NHBC) course is a technical programme for those seeking to improve build quality and to prevent common construction defects. It covers the requirements of the NHBC standards and construction best practice for all major areas of home building construction. It is aimed at site managers, assistant site managers, clerk of works, inspectors and site supervisors.



The programme will introduce the participants to the inspection process, identify common defects and outline the builder, site manager's responsibilities
