



CITB NI BUILT ENVIRONMENT STUDENT BURSARY AWARD - 2024

To encourage more school leavers to consider a career in construction and undertake a third level Built Environment related qualification, CITB NI is providing a bursary to first year full time students to assist with the cost of their training.

What is the CITB NI Built Environment Student Bursary?

CITB NI will sponsor 12 full time construction students studying a third level Built Environment related qualification (Level 4 or above) with a Northern Ireland training provider by providing them with a bursary as a contribution to the cost of their training in their first year.

Higher Level Apprenticeships are exempt, as these are already fully funded by the Department for Economy and applications will not be considered from applicants who have previously commenced or completed any other third level qualification at level 4 or above.

How much is the Bursary?

The bursary is £1,000 for each student.

What Qualification do I have to be studying?

You must have applied to study a full time third level Built Environment related qualification at Level 4 or above with a Northern Ireland training provider.

How do I qualify for the Bursary?

You must apply for the Bursary through an application process and, only if you meet the criteria, will you be entered into a draw for one of the 12 bursary awards which will be decided by random computer selection.

What is the criteria to be entered into the draw?

Applicants must:

- 1 have achieved one of the Construction related qualifications as a pre-requisite from the list found [here](#). An electronic copy of your qualification must be provided along with your application.'
- 2 have applied to study a full time third level Built Environment related qualification at Level 4 or above with a Northern Ireland training provider.

How do I apply?

You must complete an application form which can be downloaded from 13 August 2024. The application must be submitted by Friday, 18 October 2024 to amanda.stevenson@citbni.org.uk. Receipt of applications and successful applicants will be notified by email.



When do I get payment?

You will receive payment by cheque once you have successfully completed the first year of your course and provided CITB NI with evidence of successful completion such as a confirmation email or other notification from your training provider.

You must submit your evidence to CITB NI within 28 days of the date you receive your first-year results. Once CITB NI has received and verified your evidence payment will be processed within 10 days. Failure to submit evidence of your results within the timeframe will result in you forfeiting the bursary.
