


CITB NI carries out a regular programme of employer research to provide up-to-date intelligence and the evidence needed to underpin policy making and strategic decisions.

The Workforce Mobility and Skills Survey 2018/19 was commissioned by CITB GB on a UK wide basis establish reliable information on the qualification levels of the UK construction workforce and the extent of geographic and occupational mobility. The focus of the survey was on site-based manual occupations. A separate report is available for the whole of the UK construction workforce and for the NI workforce findings. This infographic will summarise the findings from the NI report.
